

Overview

The study was conducted with 1216 people 18 years old and older representing the urban population of Turkey. According to the 2016 ADNK data, the urban population constitutes 92.5% of the total population in Turkey. Sample choice was made by random sample selection based on cluster sample. The fieldwork of the research was conducted between 22 January and 27 February 2017. The field work of the study was conducted by the Frekans Research company.







To determine the attidues of the public in Turkey towards gender and family, social, and political issues that affect women's invovement in public space.








Fathers' contibutios to child care (regular contributions)














The biggest problem women encounter in society

In your opinion, what is the biggest problem women encounter in society in general?














Reason to quit the job





If a woman is the leader of the political party you support, would you still vote for the party?





