

Genel Çerçeve

The study was conducted with 1205 people 18 years old and older representing the urban population of Turkey. According to the 2018 ADNK (Address-based population registration) data, the urban population constitutes 92% of the total population in Turkey. Sample choice was made by random sample selection based on cluster sampling. The fieldwork of the research was carried out between January and February 2019 and it was conducted by Frekans Araştırma (Frekans Research).



To measure public opinion in Turkey concerning domestic, social and political issues and to ascertain the level of women's participation in the public sphere.




Political Identification

As education increases, individuals are more likely to make their own decisions to marry.










Contribution of Fathers to Child Care (regular contributions)




Contribution of Fathers to Child Care (regular contributions), by Age




Contribution of Fathers to Child Care (regular contributions), by Education


Daily childcare interest, by year








General Satisfaction, by Year









In your opinion, what is the biggest problem that women face in society?








Ensuring equal rights between men and women is one of the fundamental responsibilities of government

Abortion should be banned because it is against our traditions.



















Local Elections—A Woman Head of the Neighborhood?










How do you rate the current economic situation in the country?






Family's Economic Situation

How would you rate your family's economic situation?












Gender Perception Scale, by Year






Gender Perception Scale, by Political Identification Siyasi Yönelim göre değişim- 4 yıl toplam
