

Overview

So far this study contacted 7042 people since 2015. This year it was conducted with **2499 people 18 years old and older** representing the urban population of Turkey. According to the 2021 ADNK (Address-based population registration) data, the urban population constitutes 93% of the total population in Turkey. Sample choice was made by random sample selection based on cluster sampling. The fieldwork of the research was carried out between June-July 2021 and January-February 2022 and it was conducted by Frekans Araştırma (Frekans Research).










To measure public opinion in Turkey concerning domestic, social and political issues and to ascertain the level of women's participation in the public sphere.




Household Income (2021-2022)






Violence Against Women (2020-2021) Do you think Turkish government takes necessary measures to prevent violence towards women?


































